# **Management Objectives:**

Initial proposals for the Southern longline, tropical longline, and tropical purse seine fishery include biological, economic, social, and ecosystem objectives.

#### **Reference Points:**

- Limit Reference Point: 20%SB<sub>F=0</sub>
- **Target Reference Point**: Pending agreement on a target reference point the spawning biomass depletion ratio (SB/SB<sub>F=0</sub>) is to be maintained at or above the average SB/SB<sub>F=0</sub> for 2012-2015

# **Candidate Harvest Strategies:**

Evaluating a harvest control rule and harvest strategy through a mixed fishey modelling framework that develops modelbased harvest strategies for bigeye, but is set up to achieve objectives across multiple species, including yellowfin, skipjack, and South Pacific albacore.

# **Progress Update & Workplan:**

Initial mixed fishery framework explored via MSE; Next steps include operating model conditioning, the development of candidate management procedures for bigeye for the tropical longline fishery, and the development of mixed fishery, multi-species performance indicators. Input needed from managers on management objectives and target reference points.
